Post-Master course - 2025/2026

Objective

To train, through a multidisciplinary programme of excellence, high-level professionals with a systemic vision of rail transport and mobility.

Beneficiaries

Graduates with a master's degree in engineering. Graduating students who will obtain their master's degree by 31 March 2026 may also apply for admission.

Course organisation

60 ECTS degree course consisting of:

- ▶ 12 teaching modules. 480 hours of lectures, seminars, project work and visits to railway facilities. Lectures are given by lecturers and managers from partner companies;
- ▶ 250 hours of internship included in the training programme;
- ▶ final discussion of the project developed during the internship.

Submit your application by **31 January 2026**. The registration fee is €3,000.00.

Candidates will participate in a selection process based on qualifications, technical and linguistic knowledge (English), aptitude skills.

A maximum of 35 students will be admitted to the Post-Master's programme.

Scholarships of €3,000.00 will be awarded to the best 10 students admitted to the Post-Master's programme who attend at least 75% of the teaching hours in the classroom.

Location and duration: Rome, February to October 2026.

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
